

ASSESSMENT GENERATOR TUTORIAL

PREVIEW, DUPLICATE, ADD TO SITE, DELETE


These options are accessed from the drop down “Actions” menu

Preview: Preview your assessment as you build it.

Duplicate: You may duplicate an assessment, rename it and change the questions – this will be useful to determine whether the layout, questions, etc are more attractive to users than another with the same questions.

Clicking Duplicate will immediately create a new assessment with the same name followed by ‘(copy)’ – you will not be able to change the Type of assessment

Add to Site: Assessment insert code screen - This is the code to use in your web site to add a clickable link to your web site to give access to the assessment.

Assessment link – this is where you add text for clicking – the code will appear as indicated in the box below the copy and paste code.

To put the link on your web site, copy the entire contents of the code box (place your cursor inside the box and hit CTL-A and then CTL-C).

Then Paste the code on the page you would like your users to see the link.

Remember, the assessment is actually hosted at Assessment Generator's servers, so all you need is this link.

Delete: From the drop down menu of the assessment you would like to delete, choose Delete - This option Delete's the entire assessment
